The organizing committee would like to invite prospective presenters to submit tutorial proposals. These tutorial sessions are mainly intended to provide practical and educational new information based on novel and recently emerging research areas that are compatible with the conference topics, surveys on recent technological advances or new techniques required for industrial development.

1. Title for the tutorial.
2. Name(s) and affiliations of the presenters.
3. A short biography of the presenter(s)
4. Abstract of one to two pages.
5. Sub-topics of the tutorial with brief descriptions
6. The motivation of the proposal should be precise and clear for the attendees.
7. Required support materials from the conference organizer during the tutorial (any materials, which have to be prepared for ensuring the good running of the proposed tutorial).
